Greetings South Central Conference Parents,

Albeit, the world is continuing to deal with the effects of COVID-19, I trust this correspondent find you and your families well. As we work to offer our students a safe environment, we also want to be certain that we are offering them the most effective means of classroom instruction. Hence the reason we will be implementing the following COVID-19 procedures after returning from the Thanksgiving and Christmas holiday breaks.

- Teachers and students are required to produce a negative COVID-19 test result or proof of full vaccination after returning from the Thanksgiving and Christmas breaks.
- Over the counter, at-home COVID-19 testing kits are permitted upon returning to school after the Thanksgiving and Christmas breaks.
- In the event parents have chosen to visit a medical facility for COVID-19 testing and experience time constraints with receiving results, we have put in place several virtual school days to offer parents time to receive test results.

November 29 - December 1 (3 Days of Virtual School) – For those who have not received COVID-19 test results in time to attend **on-site school** on **November 30, 2021**.

January 4 - January 5 (2 Days of Virtual School) – For those students who have not received COVID-19 test results in time to attend **on-site school** on **January 5, 2022**.

Point of Clarity: On-site school will resume immediately following the Thanksgiving and Christmas breaks for all students and staff who have produced proof of a negative COVID-19 test result or have presented proof of being fully vaccinated.
